



## 2017 Examination Results Summary

Ashmole Academy continues to remain one of the highest performing secondary schools in London, as well as nationally. A summary of our results are provided below for your information.

### GCSE:

Congratulations to all of our Year 11 students who achieved outstanding results in their GCSE examinations.

- This was the first year of the new tougher GCSE in English and Mathematics. Our students have achieved amazing results, with 90% achieving at least a Grade 4 in both English and Mathematics.
- 3 of our students were amongst the 2000 students nationally to achieve the new top Grade 9 in English Language, English Literature and Mathematics.
- In total, 53 Grade 9's were achieved by our students in the new GCSE English and Mathematics.
- One in three students achieved the new Grade 7 in both English and Mathematics.
- 76% of students achieved at least a Grade 5 in both English and Mathematics.
- Overall, 37% of all the GCSE examinations taken by our students were awarded the top A\*/A grades.
- 64% of students achieved the English Baccalaureate with a strong pass in both English and Mathematics.

Average attainment in the 8 elements (English, Mathematics, 3 English Baccalaureate and 3 open), compared to the average of students with similar prior attainment.

English Baccalaureate 2017 = 64%

The English Baccalaureate is a measure used to provide information about a particular range of qualifications. A student is considered to have 'achieved' the English Baccalaureate if they attained a grade 5 or better in English and Mathematics, and a grade C or better in Sciences, a language and either History or Geography.



## A-Level (GCE):

Congratulations to our Year 13 students who delivered a remarkable set of results, taking them to university education.

- 32% of all A Level examinations were awarded A\*/A grades (nationally 26%)
- The Average Points Score per A Level is 38 points (nationally 35)
- 19% of students achieved AAB or higher in at least 2 facilitating subjects (nationally 17%)
- 2 students in particular deserve special recognition for achieving A\* grades in all 3 of their subjects
- 23 students achieved at least 3 A\*/A grades
- 62 students achieved at least 3 A\*-B grades
