Congratulations to all of our Year 11 students who achieved outstanding results in their GCSE examinations.

- In total, 11% of all of examination grades were awarded the elite top Grade 9
- 45% of all new GCSE examinations taken were awarded Grades 9-7
- 87% achieved at least a Grade 9-4 in both English and Mathematics
- 75% achieved at least a Grade 9-5 in both English and Mathematics

A-Level:

Congratulations to our Year 13 students who delivered a fantastic set of results leading to university education.

- 31% of all examinations taken were awarded A*/A grades
- The Average Points Score per A Level is 35 points
- 19% of students achieved AAB or higher in at least 2 facilitating subjects
- 4 students in particular deserve special recognition for achieving A* grades in all of their subjects
- 18 students achieved A*/A grades in all of their subjects
- 65 students achieved A*-B grades in all of their subjects
