<b>POST TITLE</b>	Secondary Chef Manager

<b>RESPONSIBLE TO:</b>	The Head Teacher in all matters and to The Deputy Catering Manager.
<b>WORK PATTERN:</b>	40 hours per week, 40 working weeks, Monday - Friday 6.30 am – 3 pm.

### **Employment Duties**

You will be managing all aspects of the Kitchen, including cooking, staff supervision, Health & Safety, Training and Development. Conduct all allocated duties with a positive and can do attitude, leading by example.

### **Key Tasks of the Post:**

- Responsible for the cooking, organisation and supervision of the day to day operation of the Ashmole Academy Secondary School Kitchen.
- Plan, prepare and cook food for special functions and special days.
- Ensure that food is prepared in accordance with Hygiene legislation, e.g. temperatures are recorded, foodstuffs are stored safely and hygienically.
- Ensures that dishes are produced to required standards of quality and presentation for service ensuring portion sizes and GP are achieved in line with budget.
- Demonstrates good standards of customer service.
- Responsible for stock control.
- Assists in the planning and preparation of menus.
- Clerical duties to include the ordering of supplies and the correct completion of returns.

### **Staff Responsibilities:**

- Responsible for the management, development and performance monitoring of a team of 10 General Kitchen Assistants and an Assistant Kitchen Manager.



**Responsibilities for Health and Safety:**

- Responsible for ensuring compliance with the relevant Food Hygiene Legislation and Health and Safety Legislation.
- Ensure staff are adhering to correct policy and procedures including Health and Safety, COSHH, HACCP and Manual Handling etc.
- Ensure staff are only using authorised cleaning materials, ensure the correct dilution rate as directed and used only for the purpose indicated.
- Ensure all PPE issued is worn at all times, including rubber gloves.

**You will be an effective part of the school team you will:**

- Work as part of a multi-disciplinary team.
- Take responsibility for contributing towards your own development with the guidance of your Manager and attending training courses as identified.
- Maintain school policy and procedures.
- To safeguard and promote the welfare of children.
