Dear Parents/Carers

The weather forecast for the next month mentions very cold temperatures and the possibility of snow. It is therefore advisable for me to ask all parents and carers to make arrangements in the event of severe weather leading to a school closure, either at the start of the day or with students being sent home during the day.

The school will make every effort to keep the school open as long as it is safe to do so, and safe for students and staff to come to school and go home from school.

I would therefore like to ask every parent and carer to ensure that if the school is closed for whatever reason your son or daughter can get home safely and has a key to get in, or can go to a nearby relative or friend. With younger pupils it is extra important that if the school does close your son or daughter can go somewhere supervised.

We will alert parents through MyEd and also on the website.

Please be vigilant to our announcements regarding severe weather and ensure that your son or daughter has your phone contact details.

Please note that with severe weather, conditions can sometimes change and become unsafe very quickly. In those situations the notice by the school may be short.

My advice above is all precautionary. I am hoping for a calm half term with no disruption due to poor weather.
