Re: Jeans for Genes

On Friday 23rd September 2022, the school will be supporting Jeans for Genes Day. This is an annual fundraising event to help promote the importance of charity and taking an active role in improving the lives of others.

Jeans for Genes Day raises money for [Genetic Disorders UK](#) and aims to change the world for children with genetic disorders. Individually, genetic disorders are rare but together they affect 1 in 25 children born in the UK – that is more than 30,000 babies each year. Their associated health problems mean that genetic disorders are the biggest cause of death of children aged 14 years and under.

To support Jeans for Genes Day, students will reflect on the importance of helping others and explore how they can make a difference in both the school community and the wider world.

We would like our students to support the day, by giving a donation of £2 in order to wear jeans on Friday 23rd September 2022. Students should wear their normal school uniform with jeans; their shirts, jumper and ties, however they are permitted to wear non-school uniform shoes such as trainers as long as they are appropriate for a school setting.

We would ask that donations are made either via your child's ParentPay account or alternatively students bring £2 to school on Friday 23rd September if they wish to join in with this fundraising initiative.
