Dear Parents/Carers

Re: Year 11

All subjects have now delivered feedback lessons based around the GCSE mock examinations in December. Within these lessons, students have been instructed to complete a subject feedback form with specific details about how well they performed. In the next week or so we will be sending all of this information to you and also the predicted grades.

We now begin the preparations for the forthcoming GCSE examinations this summer which start on 15th May 2023. The first stage of this is to reflect upon all of the individual subject feedback and to help students, they will collate all of this information into one document, prioritising their subjects and identifying three key areas within each subject.

On Wednesday, 1st February 2023, all Year 11 students should go directly to the hall for their assembly. Students should bring with them all of their subject exercise books for the day and will be told which lessons they can go to during the school day. Otherwise students will remain in the assembly hall and begin to undertake this reflection work.

Please could they also remember to bring in their reading book and a pair of trainers, as they may have the opportunity to either play table tennis or badminton.

Miss Clarke is currently finalising all of the intervention strategies and will share these with you all in the next week or so.
