**Re: NEU Strike Action – Vulnerable and Key Worker Pupils**

Following Mr Sullivan’s letter dated 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2023 regarding the strike action, I write to inform you of our plans to support vulnerable and key worker children.

**Key Worker Children:**

Pupils of key workers in Years 7-10 will be able to attend school as normal and will complete the same activities as those at home, under the supervision of our staff. Break and lunch times will operate with appropriate supervision in place in the normal way.

If your child is a student in Years 7, 8, 9 and 10 and you require your child to attend the Academy on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2023 as you are a key worker, please complete the following form by **Monday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2023**.
