**Re: Easter Revision**

We would like to offer an additional revision session (free of charge) during the Easter holiday, to top up all of the revision students are doing both in and outside of school. At this stage we would expect most students to be making the final preparations for their summer GCSE or A-level examinations, and these revision sessions may crystallise their application of knowledge and boost their confidence.

We are mindful that some students prefer to work independently and take advantage of the two-week Easter holiday. At the same time, as we have become accustomed to working remotely, we will be offering each revision session either face to face in school or accessible via MS Teams.

All of the subject sessions will last for two hours and in most cases, subjects will select past examination paper questions, allowing students the opportunity to apply their knowledge and then the teacher will model the answer making references to the official mark scheme.

Attached are all the subject sessions and the names of the teachers delivering the session. We do not anticipate any changes; however, a substitute teacher may be required to lead the session.

Year 11 students are not expected to wear school uniform should they wish to attend the session in school and may also bring their mobile phone. However, we still expect their conduct to be as expected during term time. Any poor behaviour will not be tolerated and if necessary they will be sent home and not permitted to attend any remaining sessions in school.
