Re: Years 9, 10 & 12 – Duke of Edinburgh Award 2025-26

As part of Ashmole Academy's commitment to personal development, we encourage and support our students to undertake as many additional extra-curricular activities as possible and understand their importance in developing a young person's confidence, talent and skills. Furthermore, these extra-curricular activities can support a future UCAS application for those considering University.

One of the awards that we encourage students to undertake is the Duke of Edinburgh Award (DofE Award). Barnet 0-19 Service supports schools, academies and colleges with the delivery of the DofE Programme across the borough. Ashmole Academy and Barnet 0-19 Early Help Service are working in partnership to ensure students can participate in the DofE Award. Ashmole Academy will be the host venue for the parents' evening and training sessions, making attendance easier for both parents and students.

Some parents applied to join the DofE Award last term. However, if you would like to find out more about it, or if you wish to join now, the enrollment evening will be held on Tuesday 30th September 2025 from 6.00-6.45pm in the main hall at Ashmole Academy. During the evening, representatives from Barnet will present on how they run the Duke of Edinburgh programme and will be able to answer any questions you may have with regards to your child undertaking the award. This session will cover all levels of the Duke of Edinburgh Award.
