Students can access this platform through their Google Classroom and should ensure they are logged into their school account.

Each subject area will also start to prepare students for these assessments, including topic lists to help students focus their preparation effectively. We encourage students to use these resources to identify areas of strength and those requiring further revision.

In addition, targeted support will be provided through Personal Development time, where students will engage in structured revision activities designed to strengthen both subject knowledge and study skills.
