Re: Year 9 Sports Day

I am delighted to inform you that we shall be holding our Year 9 Sports Day on Friday 3rd July 2026.

Students will take part in a range of sporting activities throughout the day and will represent their form group across a range of sports and activities. Each form will compete in a Rounders and Benchball tournament and they will undertake a traditional Track and Field programme of events. In addition, we will offer a range of mini competitions for students to take part in which are:

- Cricket Ball Throw

We hope that in the planning of the day we have created an inclusive and engaging programme of events so that every student can contribute to their own form group's success.
