Welcome to the New Academic Year.

We start the new academic year with our continuing commitment to delivering our vision of providing an exceptional education that enables every student to flourish academically, personally and socially.

I am delighted to begin the year by celebrating the outstanding achievements of our students. Our Year 13 students have achieved record-breaking results at both A Level and BTEC. The Average Point Scores (APS) for both qualifications are the best in the school's history, with an A Level APS of 41 points and a BTEC APS of 42 points.

Equally, our Year 11 students have responded exceptionally well to the guidance, encouragement and support provided by their teachers and the Year 11 Pastoral Team. 76% of students achieved at least a Grade 5 in both GCSE English and Mathematics, a fantastic achievement of which we are extremely proud.

These results are a true testament to the commitment and hard work of our students and staff, and reflect our school motto of 'Excellence, Aspiration and Care', together with our six school values: Reflection, Endeavour, Professionalism, Responsibility, Respect and Cooperation. They demonstrate what can be achieved when students, staff and families work together towards a shared goal.

This year, we will continue to build on this success. We want every student to be ambitious in their aspirations, intellectually curious in their learning and increasingly confident as an independent learner.
